Read Hebrews 12:15 (NIV 1984) "See to it that no one misses the grace of God."

1. We can also get too familiar with things that really matter and we can take things for granted that should be valued. Things can lose their importance when we do that. That can also happen with something as amazing as grace. Discuss.

2. Grace is best understood not by just knowledge alone, but through experience. Discuss.

3. Jesus is never recorded saying the word "grace" but he gave one of the most amazing descriptions of grace when He told the story of the Prodigal Son, a story of radical grace and unconditional love. Read the story in Luke 15:11–32 and then discuss.

4. Hebrews 12: 15 (NIV 1984) "See to it that no one misses the grace of God and that no bitter root grows up to cause trouble and defile many." Religion without grace is poisonous. Discuss.

5. Grace begins it's work on the inside of us, but we are all under constant pressure to look spiritual on the outside. Discuss.

6. People who were the complete opposite of Jesus, liked to hang out with Jesus and he liked to hang out with them. Why is it that they like Jesus so much, but not the church?

7. Grace invites us to change and then gives us what we need to see it through. When we accept God's grace and give Him our heart, He gives us something back. Ezekiel 36:26 (NIV) "I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you"
