Read Hebrews 12:15 (NIV 1984)
"See to it that no one misses the grace of God."

Pray

1. Read John 8:2-6

Jesus' enemies present him with a huge problem—
"How can truth and grace co-exist?"

The law demands punishment for doing wrong. To not follow through,
would be saying that it's OK for everyone to do whatever they want to do, with no
consequence.

Discuss.

2. Here's the trap; If Jesus keeps his compassion, it would seem that morality doesn't
matter. If he holds firm on the law, he loses his claim to a special compassion never seen
before. It seems the religiously self-righteous have trapped Jesus.

3. Read John 8:6

What does Jesus bending over symbolize?

Discuss.

4. Read John 8:7

What does Jesus standing up symbolize?

Discuss.

5. Read John 8:7-8

Jesus disqualifies the accusers

from serving as judge, jury and executioners with the truth.

Discuss.

6. Read John 8:9

The trap had backfired. Stones fell out of the accusers hands, to the ground.

But Jesus wasn't finished. He stood up again.

7. Read John 8:10

We also have someone who tries to constantly accuse us of being guilty.

Read Revelation 12:9-10

Discuss

8. Read John 8:10-111

Truth and grace co-exist. Because of truth, "don't sin anymore"

Because of grace, "God doesn't judge you guilty". Discuss. Pray.
