5. Instead of taking personal responsibility for our actions, many times, we try to blame others for what we do. Read Genesis 3:12 Discuss.

6. Pride is the enemy of confession. Read Psalm 19:13 Discuss.

7. We tend to think that confession gets us in trouble, But the truth is, confession sets us free."Remember the duck" Discuss.

8. Our relationship with God and our relationship with each other are inseparable. If we have hurt others, we need to confess that also and ask for their forgiveness. James 5:16 Discuss.
