1. Read Acts 2:22-36
 Peter gives the rest of his first sermon to the people. What he tells them are the of the Christian message. That God the Father approves of Jesus Christ His Son. That Jesus was sent to earth to die on the cross for our sins. Three days later God raised Him from the dead and now Jesus sits in honor at the right hand of God.
3. After Peter quoted from Joel, he gave us an incredible from God. Read Acts 2:21
4. To call on the name of the Lord is an act of Those who truly call on the name of the Lord realize that God is our salvation.
5. When we call on the name of the Lord and repent of our sin, God hears us, forgives us and we become a Christian and receive the Holy Spirit.
6. Read 1 Corinthians 1:2 and Psalm 91:14-15 To continue to call on the name of the Lord is a sign of our humility and dependance on God.
