1. Read Luke 13:34-35 (CSB)

8. Read Luke 13:35. Jesus gave us many promises. There's one promise that we don't get real excited about. Jesus said, "In this world you will have trouble." That's a promise. But He also promised, "I will come again." That's when all the troubles will finally end. That's a promise. That's our compassionate God.
