- 11. Read Proverbs 24:4. An important part of building a healthy home includes the interior design. Knowledge helps us fill the rooms of our healthy home with valuable things. Knowledge is closely tied to wisdom and that means more than just knowing information. It means to have a specific ability to accomplish good things. In this context, knowledge means to take the scripture and use it to direct your life.
