9. The rich guy in the story is the person who claims to be a Christian today, They attend church if it's convenient and maybe give a little bit. But they have not experienced "life change through Jesus from the inside out." The grace of Jesus is free, but it is not cheap. Read Luke 9:23
10. Jesus is teaching, that the way you use your money shows whether your heart has been changed. The way you use your money demonstrates if you love the Lord your God with all your heart, soul

and mind and if you love your neighbor as yourself.
