6. Read Proverbs 4:23 (NIV)

7. Jesus is talking to religious people, church people, who think they are good.

Who think they are not as bad as other people they know.

But God's Word does not allow the attitude of pride and self-righteousness to stand.

Read Hebrews 4:12

Why is that true?

9. Even though they were "Bible experts", they did not practice what they preached.

Read Hebrews 3:12-13
