9. Read Luke 22:65. To blaspheme means to speak evil of, to slander, to verbally abuse, revile, to swear, to cuss. We use God's name in vain not only by swearing and cussing. We use God's name in vain when we say "God told me to" when the truth is, God didn't tell you anything.
Church people have learned to use the phrase "God told me to" as a way to do what they want to do.
God DOES speak to our heart. God DOES direct our path when we trust in Him.
Just be very careful how you use, "God told me to".
10. The Sanhedrin did not care about getting justice. The only thing they cared about was to discredit and destroy Jesus. Jesus knew all of that. Read Luke 22:69
11. Read Luke 22:70-71. The religious leaders were trying to hide behind what they did not know, to try to keep from having to deal with what they did not. They had been eye witnesses to the miracles of Jesus. They could not deny the evidence that Jesus was exactly who He claimed to be. They heard Him teach with authority like no one else.
But they had hardened their heart and refused to believe.

We must soften our heart, repent of our sin and put our trust in Jesus today.
