1. Read Luke 23:33-43
2. Without the cross, there could be no empty tomb. Before the, there is a cross. What does that mean?
3. What is it in the story of Jesus that is most important? Read 1 Corinthians 15:3-4
4. The cross is impossible to We will all give an account for how we respond to the cross. Either we accept it or reject it. To fail to accept it, is to reject it.  Read 1 Corinthians 1:21-23

10. Read Luke 23:40-41. God can save. God can forgive. God can make brand new. God will accept the most unlikely people. God can bring real life change through Jesus from the inside out, even to the most unlikely people.
